Jobs for Nature 2.0 Project

Calling for Proposal

The Fijian Government with support from the World Bank invites interested registered community groups for example Village Cooperatives, Women Groups and Youth groups to submit their applications for Jobs for Nature 2.0 (JFN2) community projects.

Groups are requested to apply for small scale projects under the following activities.

a) Wetlands protection

For example mangrove planting, seagrass planting, restoring waterways, waste and wastewater management.

b) Riverbank rehabilitation and coastal bank protection

For example: mangrove planting, vetiver grass planting.

c) Enhancing biodiversity

For example forest restoration, land upgrade through native tree planting, coral reef protection.

Mode of submission of applications

Community groups can collect application forms from any of the following Ministry's divisional officers during official hours Monday to Friday. The application forms can also be downloaded from the Ministry of Economy and Ministry of Environment websites or any of the following:

- Ministry of iTaukei Affairs and iTaukei Affairs Board,
- Ministry of Youth and Sports,
- Ministry of Women, Children and Poverty Alleviation, and;
- Ministry of Rural and Maritime Development.

The Fijian Government will fund the wages for individuals in the group. Groups are to consist of 5 or more people. A completed application includes the filled prescribed application form, project proposal, and a copy of IDs for the group leader with photographs of the project site (if possible).

Applications (hard/soft copies) for JFN2 program will close by 4pm; July 15, 2022 and must be addressed to the Director – Ministry of Environment, PO Box 2109, Government Buildings, Suva.
